A little more info on this for tomorrow...the increase they are asking for would be \$24,000 in total. Currently we budget \$38,000 in that line item to reimburse paid departments for helping in unincorporated areas. We have never had a request for reimbursement but continue to budget it. If they want to increase each department by \$1,000 we could technically do that within the current budget. They would just have to be prepared to do a budget amendment for the reimbursement of paid departments (if that ever arose). I will explain this tomorrow as well...just wanted to keep you all in the loop.

Elizabeth,

For the upcoming fiscal year the MCFPA would like the commissioners to consider the following. Due to the inability to fundraise adequately because of the current pandemic, the volunteer departments within the county have experienced increased financial strain. Calls for emergency service will continue as we navigate this situation. We are asking for the contract amount to be increased to \$6500.00 per department serving McLennan County. We further request the square mileage stipend remain the same.

We also ask for the consideration of the commissioners court for the following position(s):

McLennan County Fire Marshals Office: As McLennan county continues to grow at an alarming rate, we would ask for the reconsideration of a county fire marshal. As people continue to flock to McLennan County, buying and building in unincorporated areas of the county has become the norm. With the increased population comes an increase in fire hazards. A county fire marshal would help mitigate safety hazards and violations with the hope of reducing or eliminating a detrimental event. An increase in risk will obviously cause an increase in calls for service, which will further strain our equipment and personnel.

Dedicated County Fire Dispatcher: Currently the county fire departments are dispatched by the MCSO, however, it is my understanding that we are not necessarily a priority depending on the call volume at the time. We are subjected to delayed responses often which places the citizens we serve at an increased risk. Early response in EMS could make the difference in life and death for the residents of McLennan county as well as prompt dispatching for a fire event could be the difference between a quick stop and a total loss. Property conservation is a priority to the MCFPA, early notification and intervention supports that effort.
