## ID required for Texas Voters

You must present one of the following forms of photo ID when voting in person:\*

- ★ Texas driver license issued by theTexas Department of Public Safety (DPS)
- ★ Texas Election Identif cation Certif cate issued by DPS
- ★ Texas personal identification card issued by DPS
- ★ Texas license to carry a handgun issued by DPS
- ★ United States military identification card containing your photograph
- ★ United States citizenship certif cate containing your photograph
- ★ United States passport

Do not possess and cannot reasonably obtain one of these IDs? Fill out a declaration at the polls explaining why and bring one of the following supporting documents:

- ★ Valid voter registration certif cate
- ★ Certif ed birth certif cate (must be an original)
- ★ Copy of or original current utility bill
- ★ Copy of or original bank statement
- ★ Copy of or original government check
- ★ Copy of or original paycheck
- ★ Copy of or original government document with your name and an address (original required if it contains a photograph)

\*With the exception of the U.S. citizenship certif cate, the identif cation must be current or have expired no more than 4 years before being presented for voter qualif cation at the polling place.

**Exemptions:** Voters with a disability may apply with the county voter registrar for a permanent exemption to showing ID at the polls. Voters with a religious objection to being photographed or voters who do not have a ID due to certain natural disasters may apply for a temporary exemption to showing ID at the polls. Please contact your voter registrar for more details.
