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NOTICE OF PROPOSED NON-HISTORIC USE PRODUCTION PERMITS AND PUBLIC HEARING

The Southern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District (“District”) proposes action on applications for Non-Historic Use Production Permits (“NHUPPs”), which would authorize the permittees to withdraw groundwater from the Trinity Aquifer according to the terms and conditions set forth in the permits. A copy of the general manager’s proposed action, the proposed NHUPPs and technical summaries are available for public inspection at the District’s offices at 420 North 6th Street, Waco, Texas Monday through Friday, 8 a.m.-12 p.m.

The District will conduct a public hearing pursuant to its authority under Chapter 8821 of the Texas Special District Local Laws Code, Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code and the District’s rules, to consider issuance of the proposed NHUPPs and to provide interested members of the public the opportunity to appear and provide oral or written comments to the District regarding the proposed permits at the following date, time and place:

NHUPPs are proposed to be granted to the following entities as follows:

Levi WSC, 2757 Rosenthal Parkway, Lorena, Texas 76655 – Filed application on 5/29/2013 and amended their application on 2/6/2014. The proposed NHUPP has a maximum annual withdrawal from the Trinity Aquifer of 401 acre feet (130,662,150 Gallons) for municipal use pumped from wells located at the following latitude/longitude (NAD83): N31D 23M 19S/W97D 06M 51S, N31D 23M 33S/W97D 09M 44S, N31D 23M 21S/W97D 10M 24S. The NHUPP proposed by the District for the Levi WSC has a maximum annual amount of groundwater withdrawal from the Trinity Aquifer of 63.23 acre feet (20,604,942 Gallons).

North Bosque WSC, POB 8581, Waco, Texas 76714 – Filed application on 7/30/2013 and amended their application on 1/24/2014. The proposed NHUPP has a maximum annual

withdrawal from the Trinity Aquifer of 403.25 acre feet (131,414,400 Gallons) for municipal use pumped from wells located at the following latitude/longitude (NAD83): N31D 36M 24S/W97D 18M 32S, N31D 35M 49S/W97D 21M 37S, N31D 36M 24S/W97D 19M 0.1S. The NHUPP proposed by the District for the North Bosque WSC has a maximum annual amount of groundwater withdrawal from the Trinity Aquifer of 164.69 acre feet (53,664,401 Gallons).
