CELEBRATING 50 YEARS**

**WHEREAS** On *Saturday, September 4, 2021*, former staff and alumni of **G.W. CARVER HIGH SCHOOL** will commemorate the inception, history, and legacy of the notable landmark during the **G.W. CARVER HIGH SCHOOL "PANTHERS ALWAYS & FOREVER CLASS OF 1971 CELEBRATING 50 YEARS** in Waco, McLennan County, Texas; and

**WHEREAS** In a show of public support, the *McLennan County Commissioners Court* would like to recognize the former students of **G.W. CARVER HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1971 REUNION** in McLennan County, and urges all citizens of the Waco, McLennan County, Texas, community to join in acknowledging this historical institution; and

**WHEREAS** Named in tribute to the renowned scientist *George Washington Carver*, **G.W. CARVER HIGH SCHOOL**, built on a 14-acre plot of land, opened its doors and began the task of educating, nurturing, and investing in the minds and hearts of students on September 5, 1956, under the leadership of *Principal J. J. Flewellen*; and

**WHEREAS** From 1956 until 1970, **G.W. CARVER HIGH SCHOOL**, evolved into one of McLennan County's thriving, committed, and influential institutions, growing from 500 to 1200 students and from 19 to 50 faculty members. Earning commendations in the University Interscholastic League and other academic competitions, while excelling in band and sports competitions, **G.W. CARVER HIGH SCHOOL**, after fourteen years of successful operation, due to court-ordered integration, closed its doors at the end of the 1969-1970 school year; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED**, that the **McLennan County Commissioners Court** OFFICIALLY ACKNOWLEDGES the institution once known as "**G.W. CARVER HIGH SCHOOL**" and applauds its notable achievements in nurturing doctors, lawyers, educators, nurses, businesspersons, entrepreneurs, ministers, entertainers, politicians, athletes, and other productive and contributing citizens to our community, this great state and our nation; and

## Notice of Public Hearing

McLennan County has received grant funds from the United States Department of the Treasury under the American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”). A public hearing will be held on **September 21, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.** in the Commissioners Courtroom, First Floor, McLennan County Courthouse, 501 Washington, Waco, Texas regarding the possible use of a portion of such grant funds for a new structure housing the Heart of Texas Region MHMR and a new structure housing Waco Family Medicine. The grant expenditures would be \$3,000,000 and \$2,500,000 respectively. The public is invited to attend the hearing and speak for or against these proposed ARPA grant projects.
